There's no time to scream and shout.

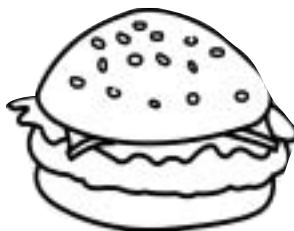
From a neighbor's phone call 9-1-1.

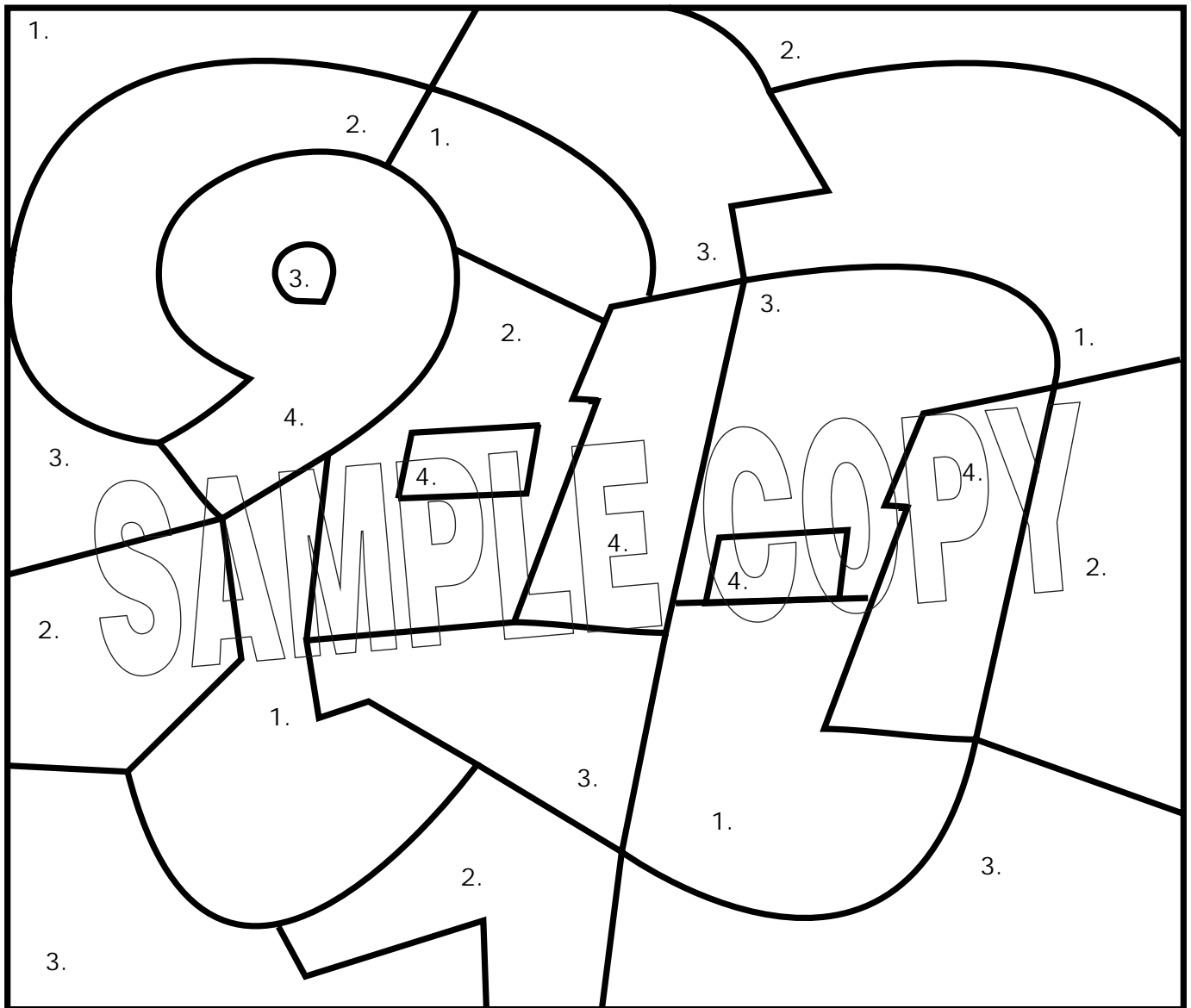
